APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Southernettes' Women's Organization will grant a one-time \$500.00 book scholarship for a top-performing graduating senior who meets the established criteria and is selected by the Southernettes' Scholarship Committee. To be eligible for the Southernettes' Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. The student must be a graduating senior residing in Harrison or Jackson County.
2. The student must score a minimum of 21 on the ACT and have a 3.0 GPA at the time of application submission.
3. The student must plan to attend and subsequently enroll in an accredited college or university in the State of Mississippi or at the University of South Alabama.
4. The student must demonstrate his or her eligibility for the scholarship by completing the attached application.

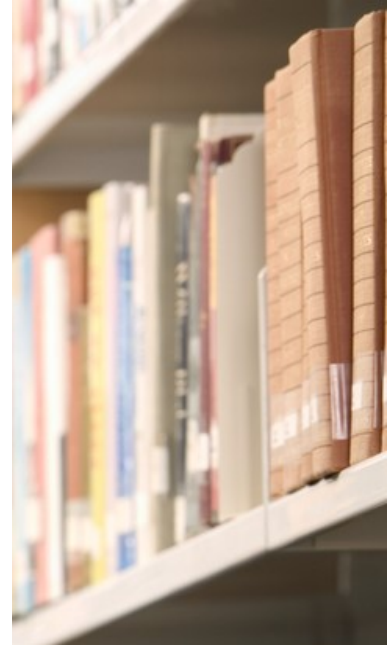

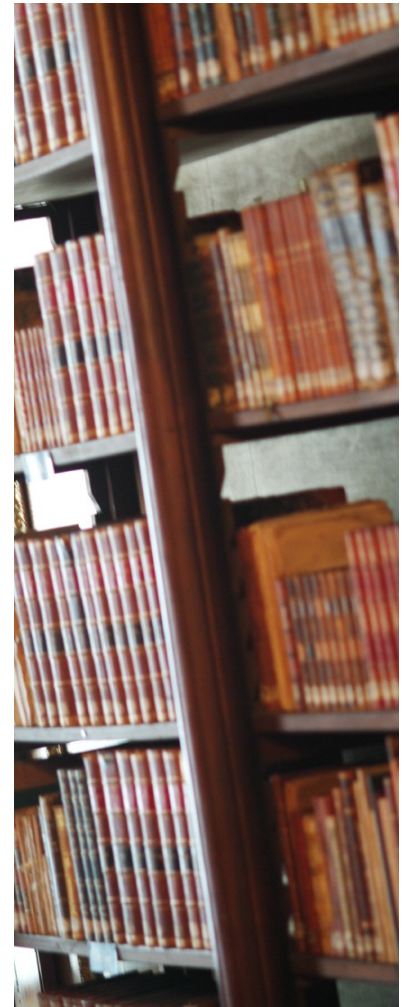
